## MARCH—MONTH OF SAINT JOSEPH

Father Stehlin recommends that all the Mass centres of Asia renew the consecration of the Society of Saint Pius X to Saint Joseph on 19 March, the Feast Day of Saint Joseph. We will gladly comply and a novena in preparation for this consecration will be prayed from 10 to 18 March. You are all invited to join.

As he was the head and guardian of the Holy Family, Saint Joseph is the protector of the Catholic Church, but he is also patron of a holy death because he died with Jesus and Mary close to him.

If you want to express your devotion to Saint Joseph and at the same time are concerned with the eternal salvation of dying people, you could become a member of the Confraternity of St. Joseph, Patron of the Dying, a confraternity founded in Saint Joseph's Church, Brussels, by Fr. Wailliez a few years ago.

Here below is the explanation of the rules which, as you will see, are not particularly demanding.

Saint Joseph is also the General Bursar of the Society of Saint Pius X for which he has always shown indefatigable care. Saint Theresa of Avila, who was miraculously cured by him, was right when she said: "I do not remember even now that I have ever asked anything of him which he has failed to grant."

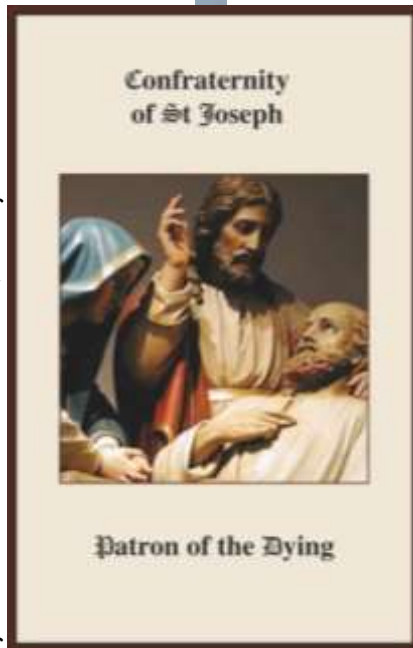
### WHAT IS THE CONFRATERNITY OF ST. JOSEPH, PATRON OF THE DYING?

It is a pious association of the faithful whose aim is to obtain the grace of a happy death for all those who

die that day. (About 160,000 people die every day in the world, that is about 2 persons per second.)

### HOW DO YOU BECOME A MEMBER?

The Confraternity is open to all. In order to become a member, you only have to fill out the application form and to return it to the St. Francis Xavier Priory, 525 Colombo Rd, Kurana, Sri Lanka, English-speaking Headquarters of the Confraternity or to email it back to [associationofsaintjoseph@gmail.com](mailto:associationofsaintjoseph@gmail.com).



The application is accompanied by a donation (SGD10) made out to "SSPX Asia", with the note: "Confraternity of St. Joseph". <http://www.sspxasia.com/donate.htm>. In return, you will receive the card of the Confraternity.

### OBLIGATIONS

- Each member of the Confraternity undertakes to recite daily a short prayer (which is found on the card of the Confraternity) and to make a sacrifice for the intention of the dying of the day.

- Each member of the Confraternity undertakes to remember the dying of the day at least once a week in the course of Holy Mass.

- It is recommended to recite regularly one of these invocations: "**Jesus, Mary, Joseph, I love you, save those who are to die this day!**" and "**St. Joseph, Patron of a happy death, pray those who are to die this day!**"

The obligations of the Confraternity do not oblige you under pain of sin.
