THE WHEELS ARE TURNING

If you keep yourself informed on how the Traditional Latin Mass is spreading all over the world, you will have to admit that the enthusiasm generated by the Mass of all times is overall on the rise.

The Catholic youth especially are more and more drawn to traditional forms of worship that promote real Catholic identity instead of the formless and insipid spirituality that shaped the mentality of their elders since Vatican II.

The renewal of the Church, although still discreet, is nonetheless and truly under way.

It is not possible for a tyrannical government to last forever. Countries held for years by a ruthless ruler eventually managed to recover their freedom. Likewise, the Catholic Church, sooner or later, will escape from the grip of the post-Vatican II tyranny, remove the light from under the bushel and place it again “upon a candlestick, that it may shine to all that are in the house” [Matt, 5.15].

Last week I received some news from a friend living in Ferrara, Italy. Abp. Luigi Negri, the local archbishop, has given one of the most beautiful churches in the city (the basilica Santa Maria in Vado, pilgrimage centre where a Eucharistic miracle took place in 1171) to Opera Familia Christi, a conservative congregation, in order for them to provide the faithful with the Traditional Latin Mass.

What a source of great rejoicing it is to see one more parish offering the true Mass to its parishioners!

For years, those who were attached to Catholic Tradition were branded as nostalgic, old-fashioned, fundamentalists when they were just the *avant-garde* in the movement of restoration of the Catholic Faith that is now steadily growing in the Church with intolerant modernists reaching old age and dying off being gradually replaced by new generations of youths thirsty for timeless values, truth and doctrine.

Archbishop Lefebvre was a visionary. He knew that the Catholic Church could not survive without the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass said in its antic form by priests desirous to seek holiness of life and edify the Mystical Body of Christ. For that only reason, he

founded the Society of Saint Pius X and its seminaries.

We shall never be grateful enough to the saintly Archbishop for having kept untouched the deposit of the Faith and passed it on. It is thanks to the determination and courage of this outstanding churchman that the most precious treasures of doctrine and liturgy of centuries of Catholicism are being used again.

Countless souls will owe their eternal salvation to this one man who did not shrink having to fight alone against all the other bishops, and even the Pope, in order to keep the Church of God Catholic.

He must be very glad to see that his pains were not in vain as a growing number of Catholics are now following his footsteps.
