IS THE TIME FOR MIRACLES GONE?



In Sri Lanka, most three-wheelers exhibit written words of wisdom expressing the spirit of their owners. Some are funny, some are serious, some manifest a positive approach to life, others are rather pessimistic. One of the latter reads: "The time for miracles is gone".

Is it so? Well, the author of that sentence must be a free-thinker or a disgruntled Catholic for that statement is utterly wrong. Miracles do happen.

On the 1st May 1836, Saint John Mary Vianney consecrated his parish of Ars, France, to *Mary conceived without sin* and placed the names of his parishioners in a heart of precious metal. The heart was then fixed on the statue of Our Lady in the church. This consecration brought countless blessings on the apostolate of the *Saint Cure d'Ars*.

Some years ago the Traditional Capuchins in France started a campaign for the promotion of such similar consecrations in traditional parishes. Actually, it wasn't a new initiative in our communities as in the French SSPX seminary of Flavigny, the custom of enclosing the names of all the seminarians in the silver heart of Our Lady's statue above the main altar has been going on for the past thirty years.

The consecration done according to Saint John Mary bears incredible fruits. I witnessed it myself.

On 25 March 2010, the Parish of Athlone, Ireland, was consecrated to the Immaculate of Mary following the example of the holy Cure of Ars. Graces were showered almost instantly. Among them was the visit of a relic of Saint John Mary Vianney (his heart!) to Ireland in Knock at the end of April when, amazingly enough, in the world tour of the relic, Ireland was not on the list of countries to be visited.

Knock is a village where Our Lady appeared in 1879. On the day of the visit, it was the first time ever that an SSPX priest

was able to say Mass publicly and officially in the church of the apparitions. Since then, the SSPX can hold in Knock its national pilgrimage every year.

Among the many graces received, I will just mention another one. A lady was to lose her job on the 4 March 2010 which was going to be tough on her family. Jobs were scarce in Ireland after the 2008 economic downturn. On the day she agreed for her name to be placed in Our Lady's heart, she received a phone call; it was an offer for a job starting on the... 4 March!

The SSPX faithful of Ferrara, Italy, were placed in the heart of Mary on 8 May 2011 along with the names of two priests of the diocese. A few weeks later, both priests were offered a parish. One of them now says the Traditional Latin Mass every day in his church (he was saying the new Mass at the time of the consecration).

Another extraordinary favour, probably brought about through the consecration as the name of the local archbishop was in the heart too, what the fact that on 1 December 2012, Pope Benedict XVI nominated to the see of Ferrara the most Catholic bishop of Italy, Bishop Negri,

who is a firm supporter of the Latin Mass. He recently gave a beautiful church to a community of priests in the city centre where the Latin Mass is said daily.

On 8 December 2013, the SSPX faithful of Sri Lanka, where the apostolate had been at a standstill for the past 12 years, were placed in the heart of Mary. In 2015, the priory was reopened with a new prior and at the end of this month, a beautiful renovated church will be nearing completion.

On 31 May 2015, it was the turn of the KL faithful to be placed in Mary's heart. Four years ago, we had 35 faithful in KL. Now, there are about 80 with newcomers appearing on a regular basis and the new chapel inaugurated on 1 July 2016 has become too small.

Who said that the time for miracles was gone?
