ALL GOOD THINGS COME TO AN END

Four years ago, we had the great pleasure to meet, with some of you for the first time, with others for the second or more!

Four years are already gone and it is time to say Goodbye.

With this last editorial, I would like to express my heartfelt gratitude to each and every one of you for your constant support and generosity.

I will cherish fond memories of the Singapore priory and of its faithful, of their kindness and fervour.

Yes, fervour. Indeed, let us consider the following: in 2013, we used to have a headcount at every Sunday Mass. The result was that around hundred and fifty faithful attended the Sunday ceremonies on a regular basis. Then, we stopped the headcount until recently, when I asked for a new one to be done out of curiosity.

In the course of these past four years, we lost about thirty five parishioners, mainly because of emigration; a small number joined the so-called “resistance” and a few others decided they wanted to go elsewhere for various reasons.

The total for the latest headcount was again hundred and fifty. It means that within four years we gained about thirty-five new faithful in order to par the level of 2013, which is not bad at all.

Since then, newcomers have been attending our Masses manifesting the fecundity and attractiveness of the Mass and doctrine of all times.

This is the result of your prayers and sacrifices, so keep up the good work. God always blesses fervent communities.

Next week, I will fly to Sri Lanka to take up my new posting. This forthcoming transfer to Sri Lanka will be number 9 for me. Nine postings in

twenty-two years of priesthood, that is an average of a new priory every two and a half years.

These various transfers that took place in eight different countries were an amazing source of enrichment but also a cause of sadness as parting is always a painful experience.

Let us keep each other in one’s prayers, united as we stand in the service of Our Lord Jesus Christ and His Holy Roman Catholic Church.

Remember that our relatively small number compared to the wider Catholic community should not discourage you. We are not meant to convert the whole world. We have been given by Divine Providence a task similar to that of the work of the medieval copyist monks who zealously and faithfully kept all the treasures of Western culture and civilisation in their monasteries until the long-sought-after time of peace arose when the scholars could dig out from their precious libraries all that was necessary for society’s rebirth.

In our priories, we keep the flame of Tradition burning, waiting for the favourable moment when God uses it to set His Church on fire with the power of His Holy Spirit in order to renew the face of the world.

Until such time, let us be grateful to Our Lord for having given us access to all the spiritual riches of the Church in this time of confusion.

Let us carry out our duty of conservation and transmission with open-mindedness, great joy and boundless charity.
