JUST A FEW REMINDERS...

Respect towards the Blessed Sacrament - The Mass time is posted on the bulletin. If you arrive late for Sunday Mass by your own fault, you already start it by offending God. If you know it will take you time to find a parking place, leave home a little earlier... The best way to arrive on time is to arrive half an hour before Mass. Then, you can go to confession and say the Rosary with the other faithful.

As St. Bede the Venerable says: "What do we think the Lord would do if He found people quarrelling, or listening to fables, or giving way to laughter, or entangled in any other wickedness, when He saw those who were buying in His Temple victims which were to be offered to Himself, and made haste to cast them out?" "Especially", Cornelius a Lapide continues, "when these buyers and sellers did not lodge in the Temple itself, strictly speaking, but only in a court of the Temple, indeed in a court common to all nations; and yet they were cast out by Christ from thence: what then will He do to Christians who perpetrate these and worse indignities in His Temple before the Holy Sacrament? Learn from hence how great reverence is due to the Temple, such indeed as is due to God's House, for Christ calls it *My house*." - Do not speak inside the chapel, please. Greet fellow parishioners inside the chapel vestibule (book shop area) or outside.

As Fr. Stehlin stated, during the Sung Mass on July 16: after receiving communion, go back to your pew right away. Do not stay for some time at the communion rail nor stop in front of the crucifix for your private devotions. (The crucifix is beautiful, but it is only an image of the One whom you now have in your heart. Come and worship the crucifix at leisure, outside of Mass).

Altar boys, do not place your hands on the altar; it has been consecrated by a bishop. Only the celebrant can, during a liturgical function.

Respect for the priests' privacy - If you need to speak to a priest (for confession, for a Mass intention, etc.), ring the bell and wait downstairs. If the priest does not show up, it means that he is either away or busy. In other words, do not go and knock at the door of the office. (Send him a message, if you want.) The office is off limits.

Just after Mass, you may wait for Father outside the sacristy (in the cry room).

If you already have an appointment with a priest (marriage class, etc.), go straight up to the library where Father will meet you.

Respect for the priest and the other parishioners- If your infant / baby cries or makes cooing and gurgling sounds or babbles, he is most likely disturbing fellow parishioners. The cry room has been purposely built for your little angels. We are on the point of fixing the screen and sound system so that you may not miss the sermon.



Energy consumption - If there is no one behind you when you leave the toilets or the confessional, switch off the light, please.
