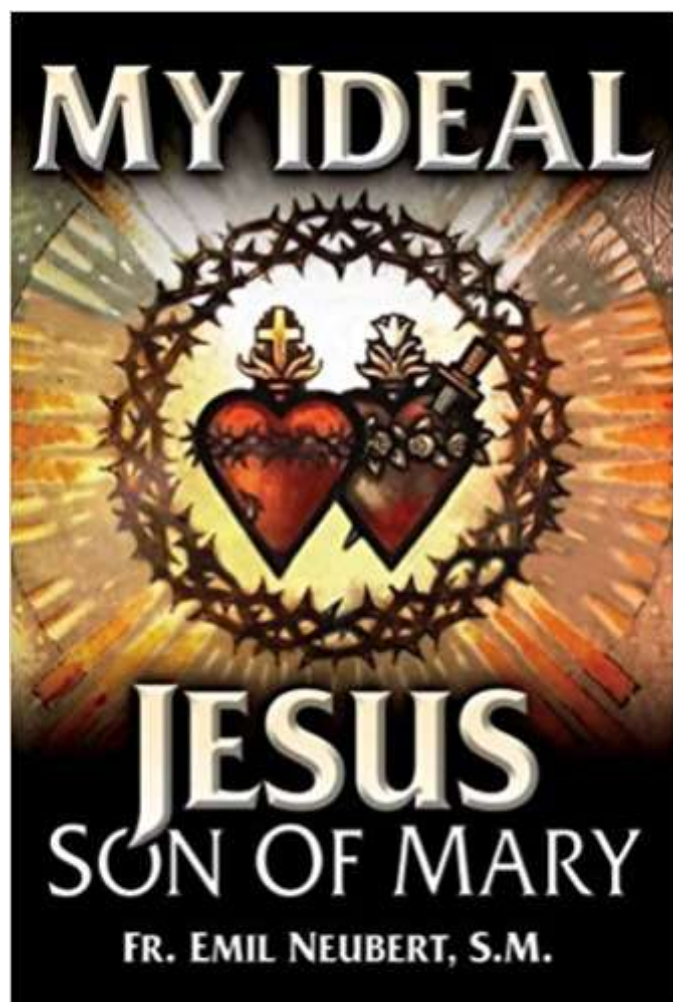

MY IDEAL: JESUS, SON OF MARY

The Christian who aims at perfection endeavors to imitate Jesus Christ as completely as possible. Among all the traits of the Divine Model one of the most beautiful to imitate is His filial piety to Mary our Mother — His Mother and ours.



My Ideal has been found to be an efficient aid in this Marian program of life. It leads to a firm, manly, intimate devotion of consecration to the Blessed Mother. It is presently treasured by many priests, sisters, brothers and lay people, young and old, as a blueprint for a Christian way of life under the aegis of Mary Immaculate.

It is a practical manual for sodalities, Catholic Action groups, schools, novitiates, and seminaries. The chapters are suited for reading, study, and meditation on the days of May and October.

Called a "School of Holiness," this little book by

Father Neubert, SM, synthesizes and presents the Marian teachings of Father Chaminade, founder of the Marianists. In a conversational format similar to *The Imitation of Christ*, Jesus and Mary teach us how to be "Sons of Mary" by imitating the filial devotion of Jesus Himself. Loved and promoted by St. Maximilian Kolbe, translated into everything from English to Zulu, this spiritual gem has been reprinted in a booklet destined for mass-distribution! St. Maximilian Kolbe wrote, "The Marianist E. Neubert has published a book entitled *My Ideal: Jesus, Son of Mary*. The spirit that pervades this book is entirely the same as ours."

In *My Ideal*, Mary says this on page 49:

Speak to Him as if you saw Him. Is He not in you? Does He not hear your voice as truly as He formerly heard St. Peter's, St. Mary Magdalen's, and St. John's? Does He not love you as He loved His disciples; you especially, whom He has given to me, like John, my child of predilection? Speak to Him directly, without any set formula of prayer. Tell Him in all simplicity what you are thinking, what you are feeling, and what you desire, just as you would speak about it to a brother or an intimate friend.

There are tips that can really change how your morning prayer time and your middle-of-the-day-in-the-midst-of-chaos prayer pleas sound.

Not sure how to do it? Mary mentions, right after the quoted passage, "*Do not forget to unite yourself to me in these intimate conversations with Jesus.*"

This book is uplifting, even as it's challenging. It's imaginative, even as it's practical. It's packed with material, even as it's short and quick to read.

This little book leads the soul to be an apostle in daily life; bringing others to Jesus and Mary. A complete, practical program of life, uniting one to Jesus and Mary. Beloved spiritual classic.
