SINS AGAINST THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

In 1930, Our Lord told Sr. Lucy of Fatima: *"My daughter, there are five ways in which people offend and blaspheme against the Immaculate Heart of Mary:*

(1) Sins against the Immaculate Conception.

On 21 December 2018, Pope Francis suggested that Mary was not born a saint, but worked to "become" one.

"Our Lady and Saint Joseph are 'overflowing' with holiness and therefore with joy. And you will tell me: of course! They are Our Lady and Saint Joseph! Yes, but let us not think it was easy for them: saints are not born, they become thus, and this is true for them too," he added.

(2) Sins against her Perpetual Virginity.

On 23 December 2018, Bishop Manuel Linda of Oporto, Portugal, stated "we should never refer to the physical virginity of Mary. The Old Testament says many times that Jesus was to be born of a maiden, a daughter of Israel, who was simple, poor, and humble. But this is truly just a reference to the full devotion of this woman to God. The gift of being mother of God was given to Mary because she had an undivided heart. What matters is full giving of herself..." In explicit detail, he further stated: "There certainly are women with a ruptured hymen who are more virgin in the sense of full devotion to God than some with an intact hymen." Catholic doctrine holds that Mary was a virgin before, during, and after Christ's birth. Direct reference to it is found within the Lateran Council of 649 A.D. where it is stated that "Mary conceived 'without any detriment to her virginity, which remained inviolate even after his [Jesus'] birth.'" To state anything other than this is in direct contradiction to the Catholic Faith.

(3) Sins against her Divine Maternity and at the same time the refusal to recognize her as the Mother of all mankind.

On 12 December 2019, Pope Francis declared that "[Mary] never introduced herself as co-redemptrix. No. Disciple," he said. She "never stole for herself anything that was of her son," instead "serving him." "When they come to us with the story of declaring her this or making

that dogma, let's not get lost in foolishness," he said.

(4) Sins of those who seek openly to foster in the hearts of children indifference or contempt and even hatred for this Immaculate Mother.

Madonna Louise Ciccone, better known as "Madonna" has had a long history of offending the Catholic Church, Our Lord and Our Lady through her provocative and blasphemous songs and concerts.



(5) Sins of those who directly outrage Her in her holy images.

A new commercial for the Christmas season produced by the Norwegian Postal Service, Posten Norge, suggests that Christ's conception in the Virgin Mary's womb was not miraculous, and that He was really the mailman's son.

The ad not only denies Jesus' divinity and the Virgin Birth, it implies that Mary was unfaithful to Joseph, willingly having sex with any man who knocked on her door.

"Here then, My Daughter, is the reason why the Immaculate Heart of Mary causes Me to ask for this little act of reparation and by means of it, moves My mercy to forgive those souls who had the misfortune of offending her. As for you, try without ceasing, with all your prayers and sacrifices, to move Me to mercy toward those poor souls."
